Students of Classes IX & X will be tested on the whole year portion. Periodic tests are conducted during the academic year with portion of syllabus cumulatively covered. The average of these periodic tests will be taken for final periodic test marks (brought to 20%) and submitted to CBSE. Board will conduct examination for 80 marks in each subject covering 100% syllabus of the subject of class X only. Marks and grades both will be awarded for individual subjects.
